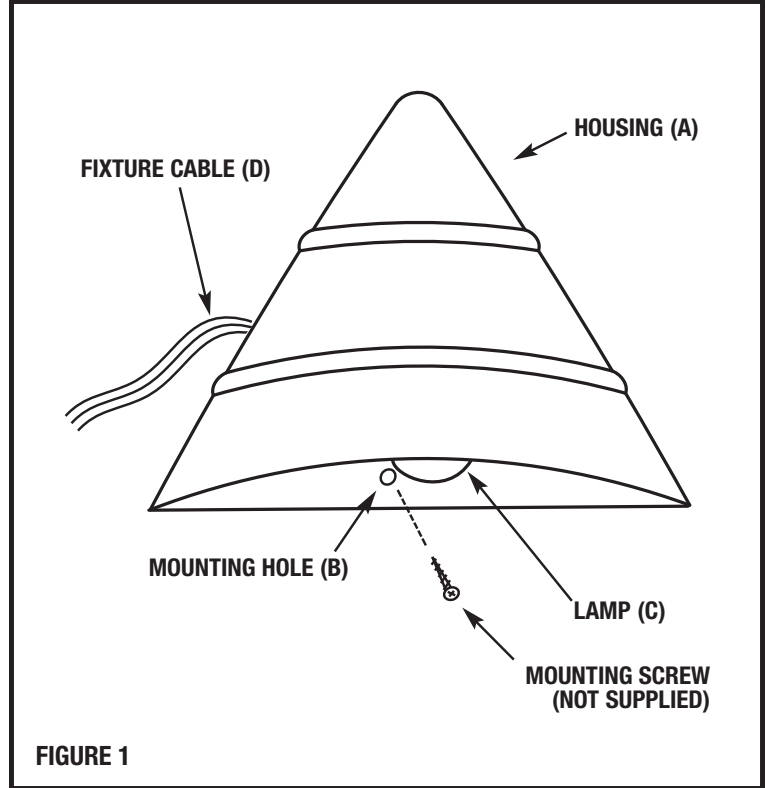


IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Be sure the electricity to the system you are working on is turned off; either the fuse removed or the circuit breaker set at off.
- Use of other manufacturers components will void warranty, listing and create a potential safety hazard.
- Read and understand these instructions before installing fixture.
- This fixture must be installed outdoors in accordance with the National Electrical Code and local regulations.
- Retain these instructions along with instructions supplied with transformer for cable connection.
- **WARNING: RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK** – Install all luminaires 10' (3.05M) or more from a pool, spa, or fountain.
- The main low voltage cable is intended for shallow burial—less than 6" (152mm).
- When additional lengths of main low voltage cable are necessary, order Ambiance® landscape outdoor cable. Please visit SeaGullLighting.com to find a local distributor.
- Save these instructions.

INSTALLATION

1. Drill a 1/4" hole through stud or other mounting surface to run fixture cable (D) to main supply cable. Be sure that mounting surface covers entire back of fixture housing (A).
2. Drive a hanging screw (not included) just slightly above where you wish the center of the fixture to rest on the mounting surface. The head of the screw should protrude about 1/8" above the surface.
3. Install lamp (C) into fixture housing (A).
4. Connect fixture wires to low voltage supply wires using a silicone filled landscape wire nut or other listed landscape wire connector.
5. Place housing (A) over screw using keyhole slot in back of housing (A).
6. Drive a 1/4" screw (not supplied) through mounting hole (B) to secure housing (A) to mounting surface.
7. Connect fixture wires to low voltage supply wires using a silicone filled landscape wire nut or other listed landscape wire connector.
