

1. Make trench for stake (B) and cable in ground.
2. Run cable through stake (B) and thread stem (A) into top of stake. If stem slips through clearance hole at the top of stake, thread stem into the wedge area of stake.
3. Insert bulb into socket.
4. Make connection between fixture wires and low voltage supply wires using wet location silicone filled wire nuts or other listed landscape wire connector.
5. Insert stake (C) into trench and tamp ground around stake (C) to secure in place.

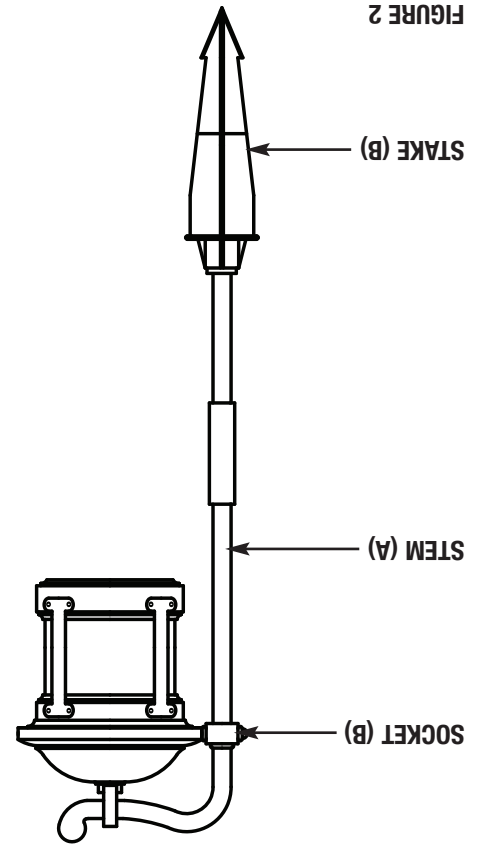

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

 - Lighted lamp is HOT!

 - Do not operate the luminaire fitting with a missing or damaged shield.

 - The main low voltage cable is intended for shallow burial—less than 6" (152mm).
