





## INSTRUCTIONS

### I. Wiring the Fixture

1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around, or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
  - a) White fixture wire to neutral power line wire
  - b) Black fixture wire to hot power line wire
4. Secure the fixture to the post with post screws.
5. Install the candle tubes by sliding them over the sockets.
6. Screw the lamps into the sockets. Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage Information.
7. Install the provided tape to the ends of the glass, insert the glass into frame, and secure it by ensuring that the tape properly sticks onto the frame.
8. Place the cover on top of the fixture and secure it in place with the cover screws.
