## INSTRUCTIONS

### I. Wiring the Fixture

1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
  - a) White fixture wire to neutral power line wire
  - b) Black fixture wire to hot power line wire
4. Carefully tuck all the wires and wire-nut connections in the junction box, mount the fixture base onto the threaded studs, and secure with cap nuts.

### II. Installing the Fixture

1. Screw the lamp into the socket. Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage Information.
2. Carefully insert the glass panels into the fixture and secure them in place using the provided clips.
3. For wet locations, caulk around the base of the fixture with waterproof construction sealant.
